## Reflection

When asking good questions, teachers need to use a variety of comprehension questions that go beyond the ubiquitous *yes/no* question "Do you all understand?" Students tend to all nod their heads affirmatively in response to such questions. Instead, teachers should ask questions that elicit answers from students that actually demonstrate their comprehension. What might these questions look like?
