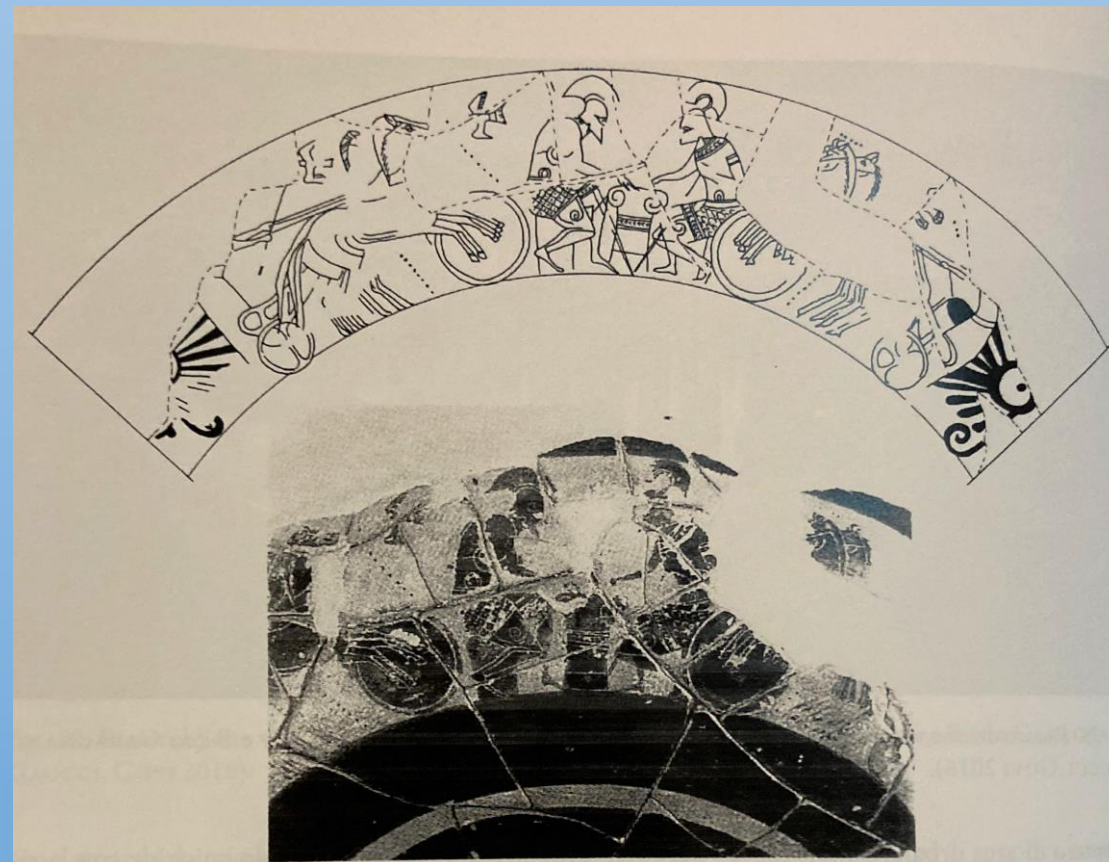
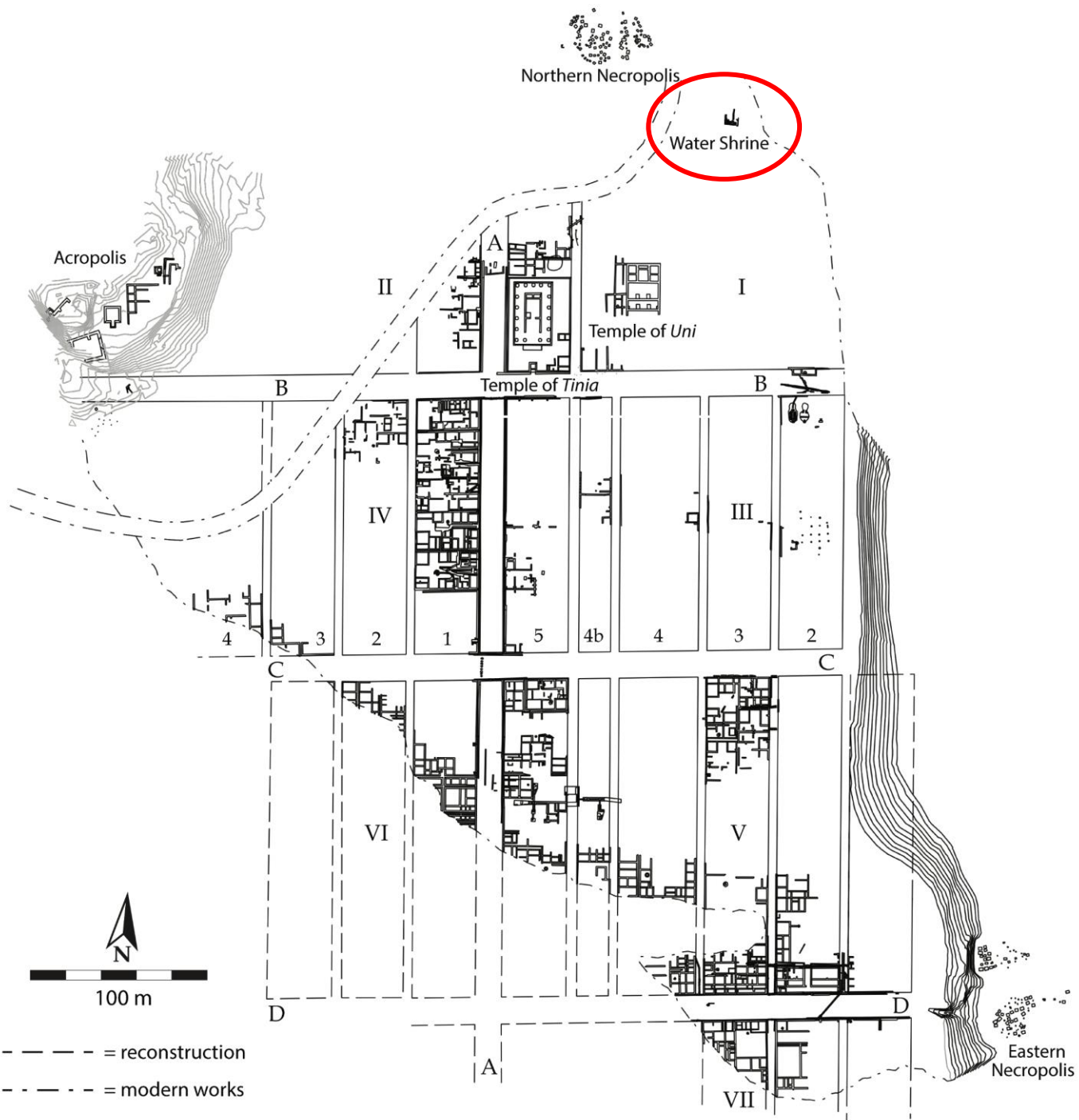


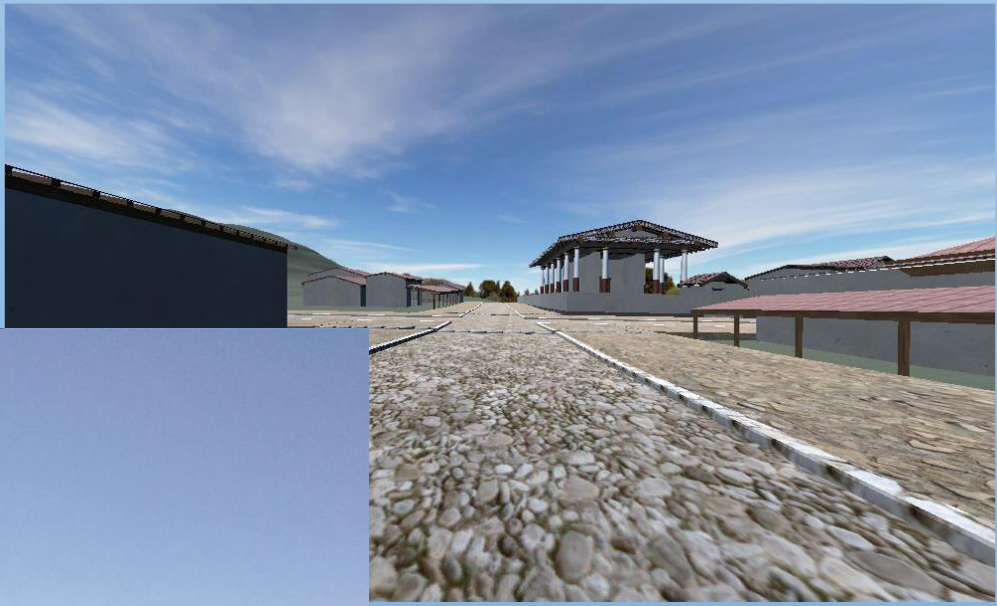
















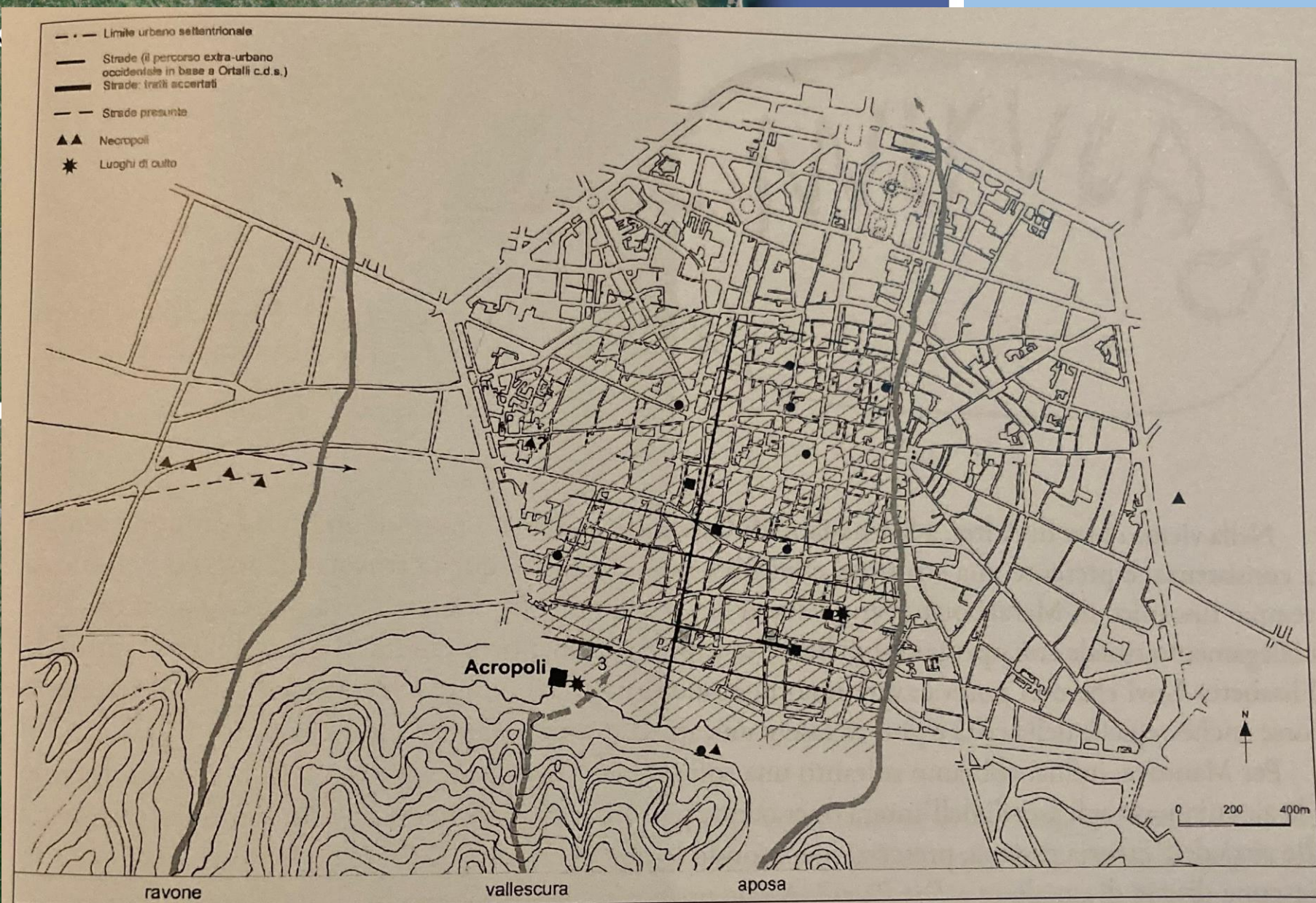
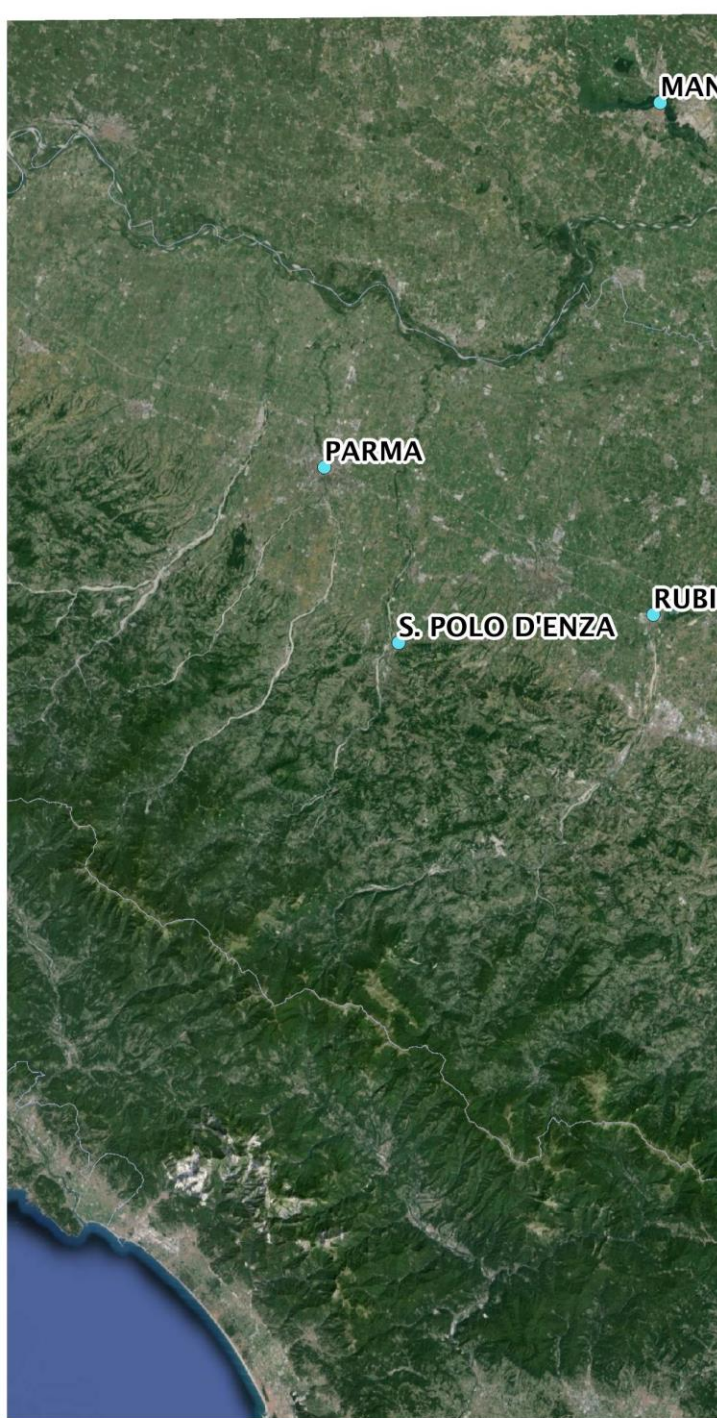
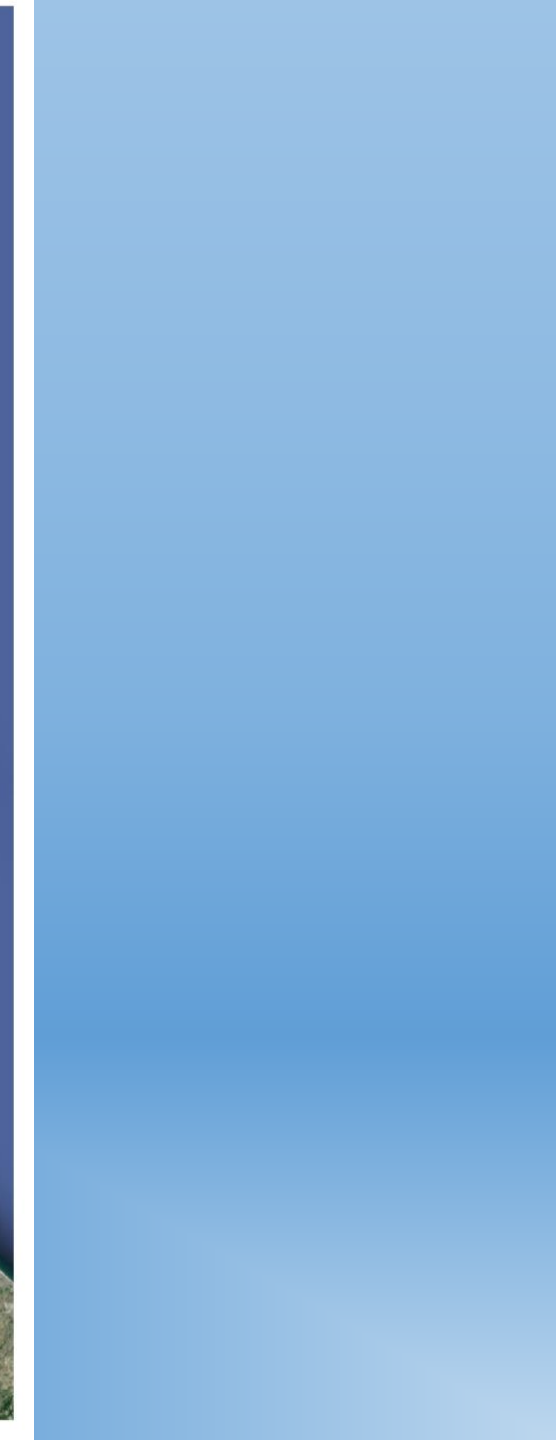
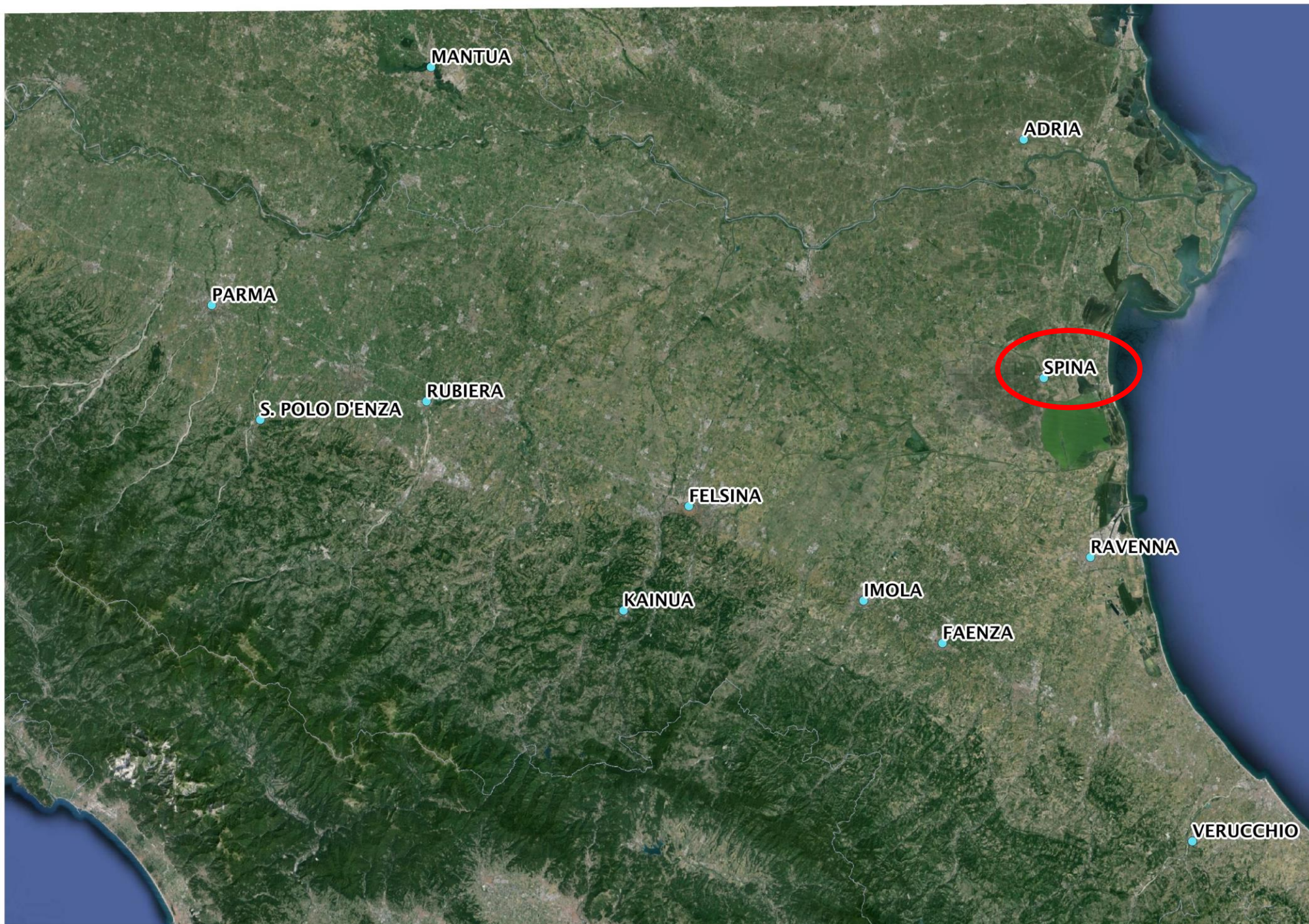
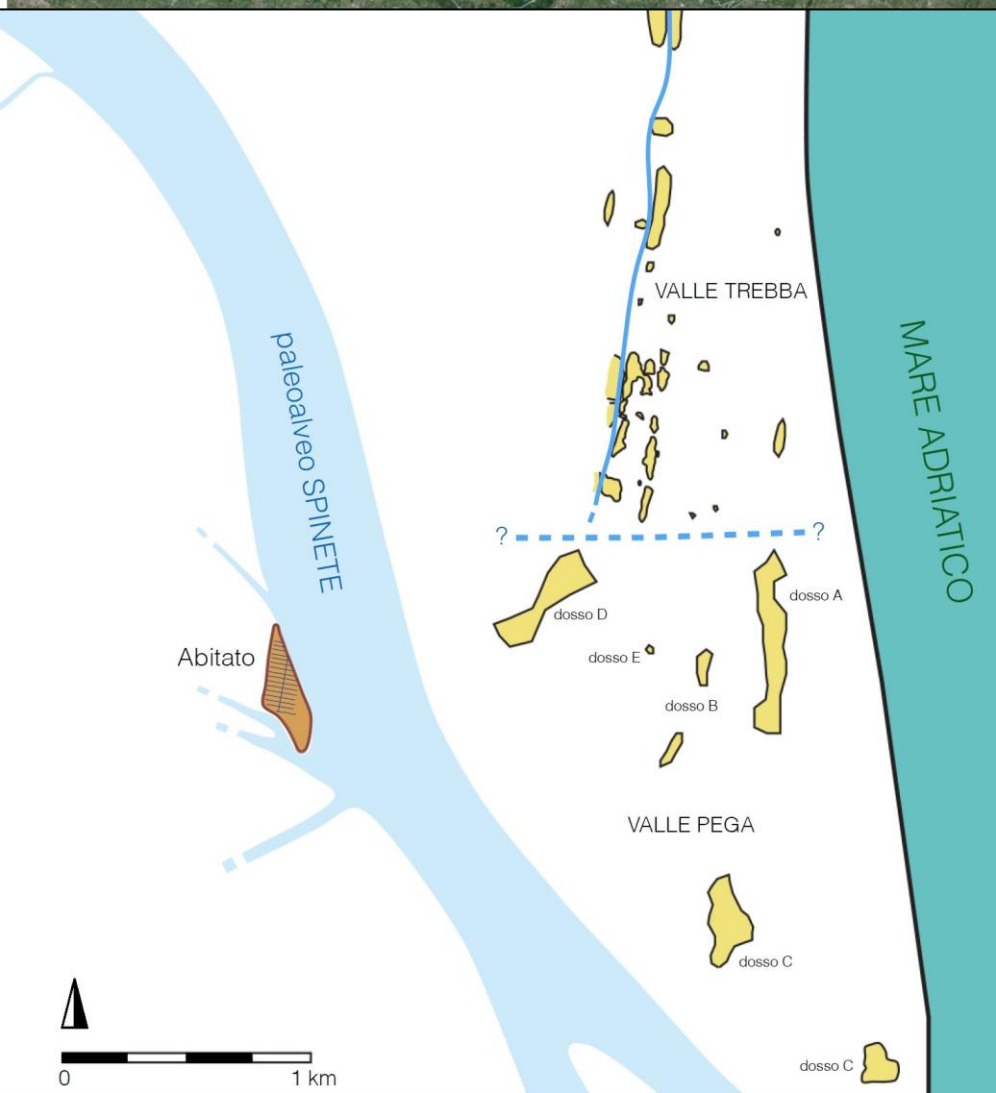


Fig. 4. Pianta della Bologna etrusca con ipotesi di reticolato stradale regolare (da MALNATI 2010).

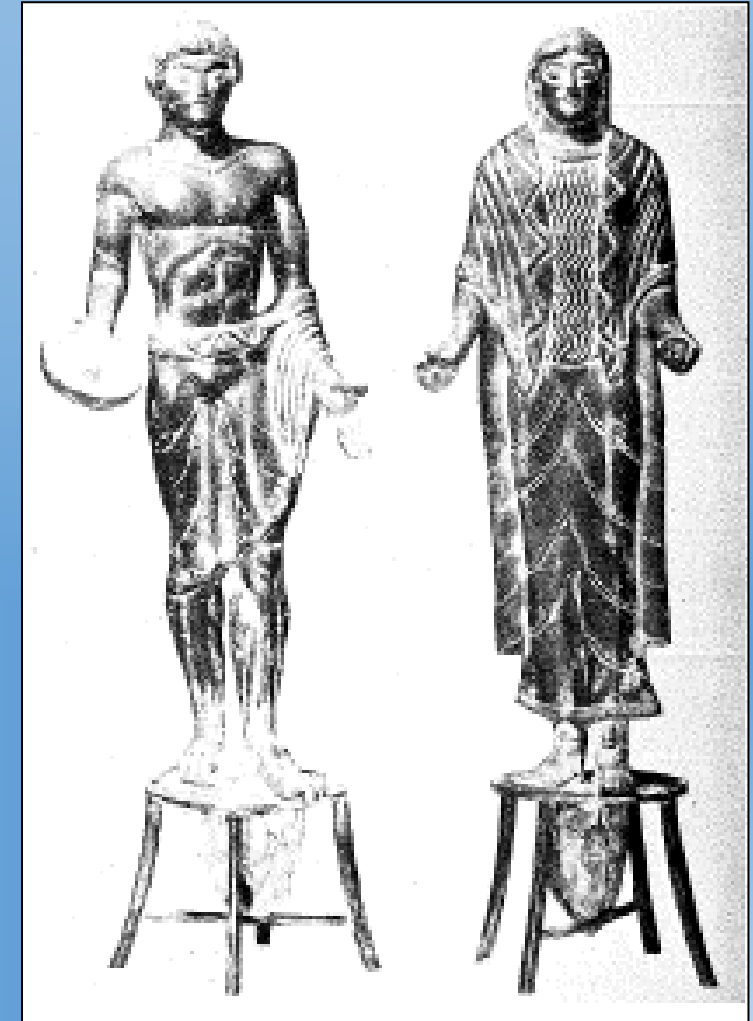

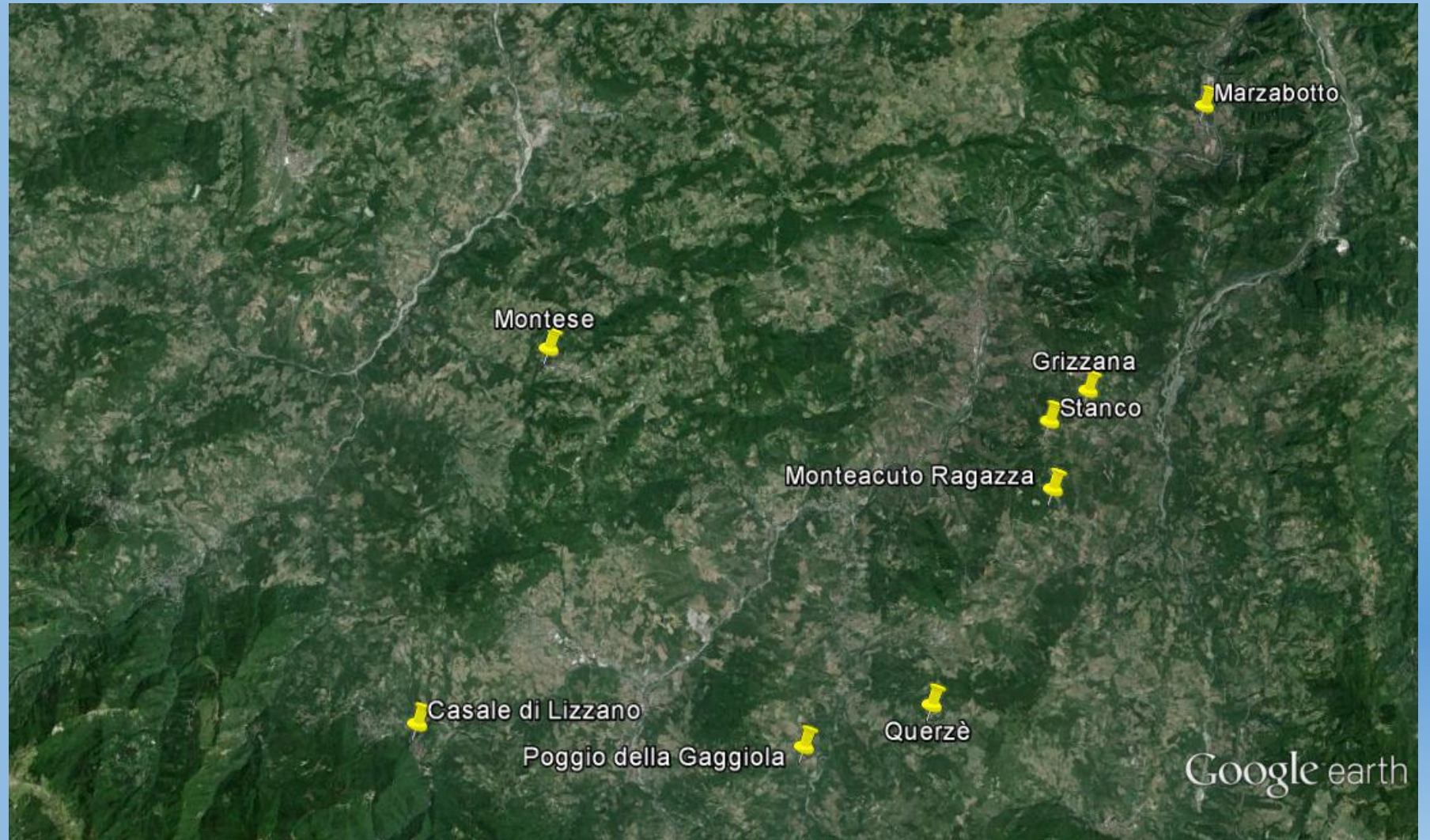


Rinvenimenti di bronzetti votivi nei dintorni di Marzabotto

Tra questi, il meglio conosciuto è forse quello di Poggio della Gaggiola, circa 22 km a monte di Marzabotto.

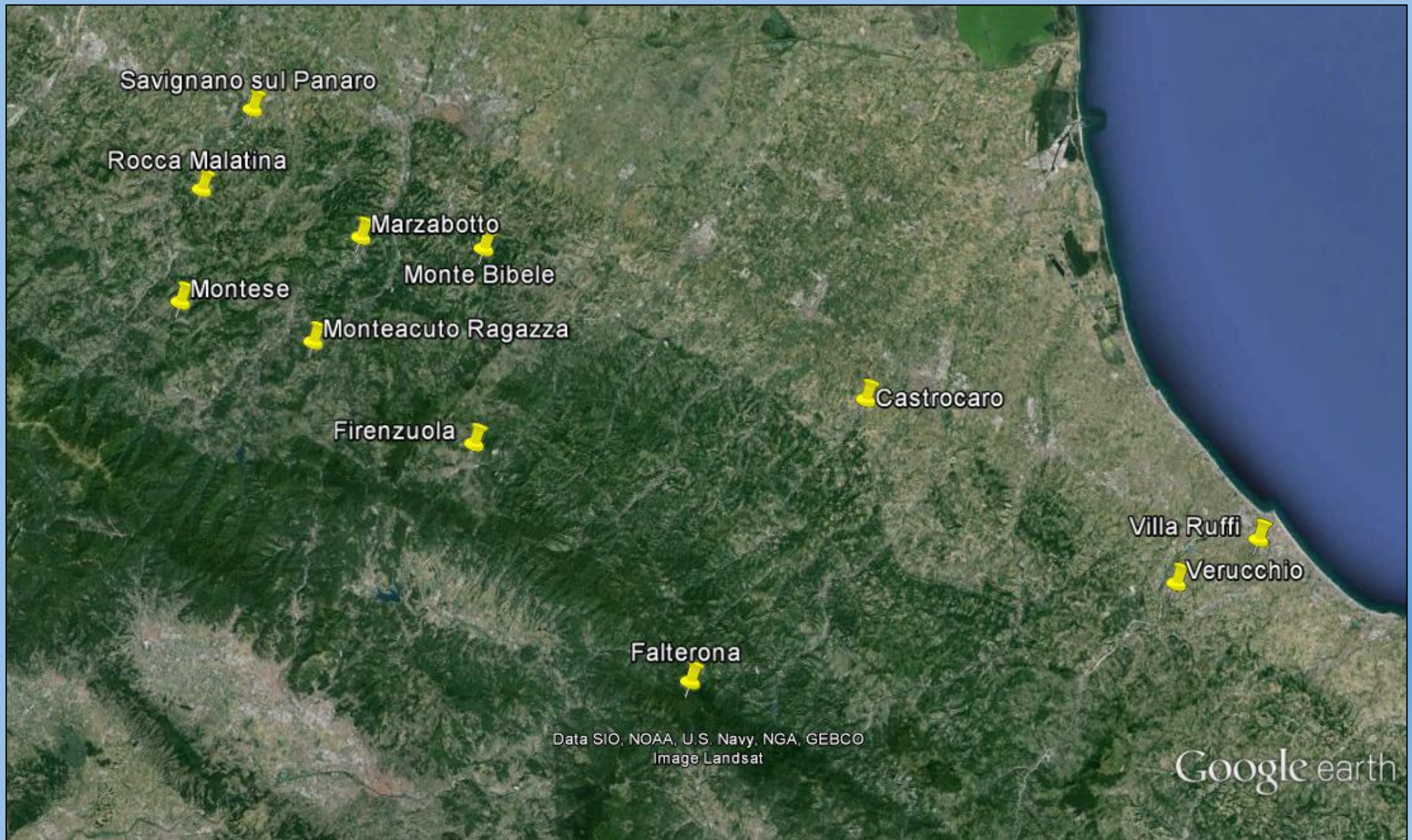
Le prime indagini di fine Ottocento restituiscono una statuetta in bronzo di guerriero, una statuetta zoomorfa, ceramica acroma e a vernice nera (in particolare una ciotola graffita internamente «*masu*»).

Indagini condotte a metà Novecento hanno testimoniato un'occupazione durata fino alla fine del IV o agli inizi del III sec. a.C.
