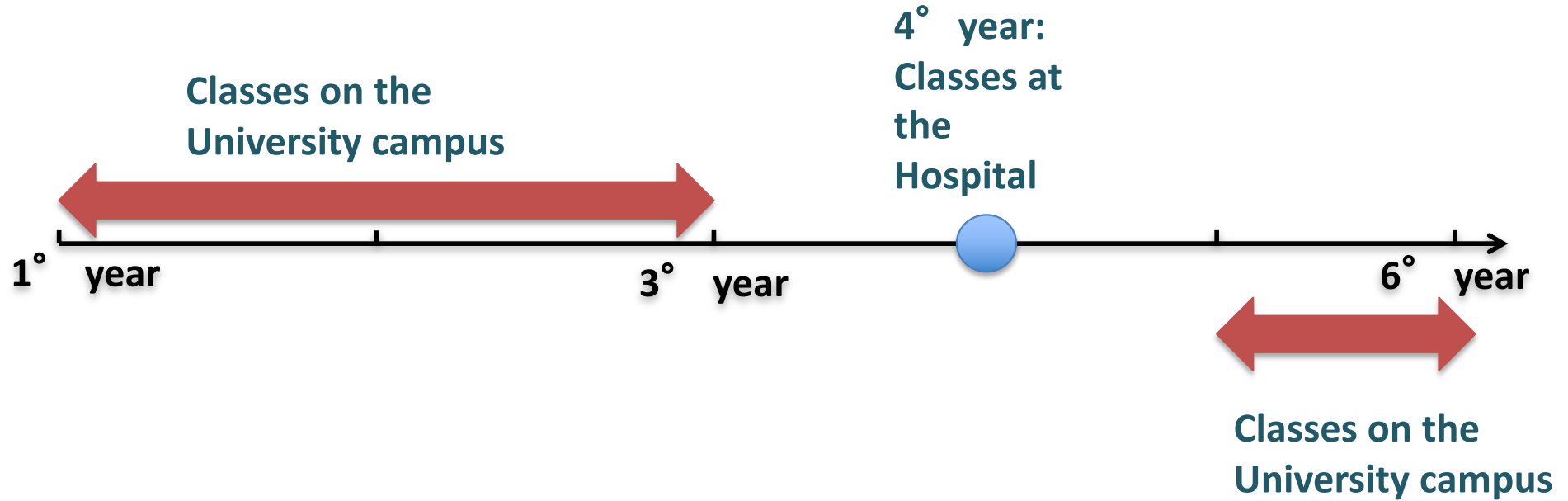

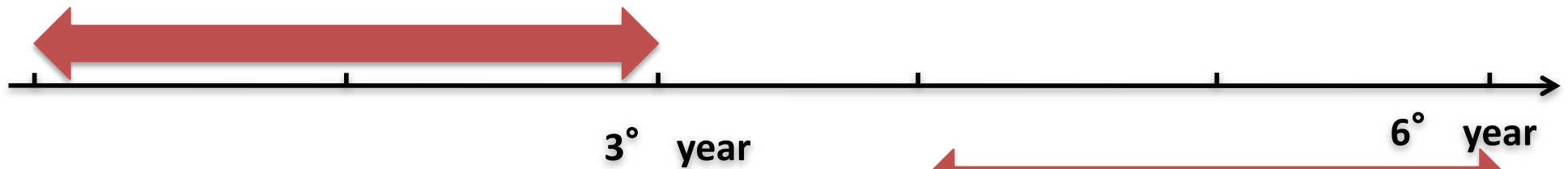

# Courses : for all 6 years (attendance rules)



1. Attendance will be recorded for each course.
2. To be eligible to sit for the exams, students must attend at least **67%** of the course lessons and practical activities and fill in the OPIS questionnaire
3. According to the study regulations, there are no restrictions on enrolling in the following year of the course. **HOWEVER,**

# Exams: first 3 year-period

## Rules of progression



**IMPORTANT:**

**to sit for the exams of the subsequent years**, students must follow the rules outlined in the table below.

4 <sup>th</sup> year	All the exams of the first and second year and 1 exam from the third year
5 <sup>th</sup> year	All the exams of the first, second and third year
6 <sup>th</sup> year	All the exams of the first, second, third and fourth year and 2 exams of the fifth year

# Examination modalities: formal assessment



*The aim of exams is for students to demonstrate their knowledge and skills in both written and non-written format.*

**Written** – may include multiple choice questions, open-ended questions or problem-solving tasks.

**Oral** – involve discussing the epidemiology, pathophysiology, signs and symptoms, prognosis, and treatment of a specific disease or evaluating a clinical case.

Grades are expressed on a scale out of 30, with the limits:

- 18 (minimum)
- 30 with honors (Italian: 30 e lode) (maximum)

# Examination modalities: formal assessment



**We have two main types of exams:**

**Ongoing (Esonero)** – for some courses with multiple modules, ongoing exams are available. Students will receive a grade, which will count as part of their final mark, received after completing the final exam. The exam can be written or oral.

**Final** – This is the more common type of exam. If the student passes, they will receive a final grade, and the course credits will be awarded. It is almost always oral. Some final exams also have a practical part in which the student is expected to demonstrate clinical skills (e.g. evaluating blood tests, performing physical examination on mannequins...)



# Examination modalities: dates & registration



By law, there are **3 official exam sessions**:

January-February

September

June-July



In addition, special sessions can be organized upon request during the winter holidays.

**OVERLAPS BETWEEN LECTURES AND EXAM DATES ARE NOT ALLOWED. THE ONLY EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE IS FOR FUORI CORSO STUDENTS, WHO ALREADY ATTENDED ALL LECTURES. THEY CAN REQUEST ADDITIONAL EXAM DATES.**

Exams are booked through: **INFOSTUD**

Ongoing exams are also booked on **INFOSTUD** (prove intermedie, see instructions on Moodle)

Exam dates represent **the first day of the examination**, but the process **may extend over the rest of the week** if there are many students taking the exam at the same time.

**Infostud 2.0** is the online platform of the university where you can:

It is paramount that you upload your ID, contact details, home address (in Rome) and keep the information up-to-date.

# Student Opinion Questionnaire (OPIS): your feedback is important!

It is possible to evaluate, **during class time**, every didactic module or part of the didactic module in co-teaching.

If the lecturer deems it necessary (e.g: few students attending the course that day), they can repeat the evaluation questionnaire in class on a different time before the end of the course.

Students enrolled in following years than the one provided for a given course may also fill in the questionnaire unless they have already did so in the same academic year, having already registered for the exam, without passing it.

To reduce the number of questionnaires required for modular courses or with several lecturers, **a single questionnaire relating to the course as a whole** will be requested when booking the exam.

Your evaluations are **totally** anonymous. It is important to fill the OPIS during course attendance, and not at a distance, when you enroll for the exam. A special committee is made up by a Teacher (prof. Carla Giordano) and two Students (Daria De Benedictis and Elisabetta Rossi) who will analyse your feedback to improve our performance.

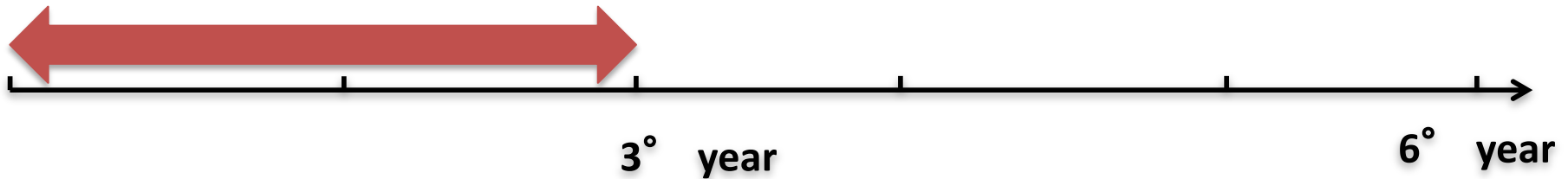

# Being Motivated and on Time Gives Opportunities

Starting your degree course strong and finishing the exams of the first three-year period ***on time*** with ***good grades*** provides the opportunity to:



Accessing the ***Honour Path*** (Percorso di eccellenza) (IV year)

Starting the ***qualifying traineeship for graduation (TPV)*** and ***thesis*** early (V year)

# Honour Path (percorso di eccellenza)



**Percorso di Eccellenza (Honor Path) is an additional research program for students who have completed all 3rd-year exams by the beginning of the 4th year with an average score above 27/30.**

This program serves as an integrative pathway, offering supplementary training activities beyond those in the standard course of study.

It includes interdisciplinary teaching activities and internships designed to foster students' talent and interest in research, allowing them to participate in research projects under the supervision of clinical and/or laboratory professors and tutors.



# TPV and Thesis



**TPV is the qualifying traineeship for graduation, which begins in the 5th year for students who have completed all their 1st to 4th-year exams on time.**

To graduate, each student must participate in a research or clinical program and complete, then defend, a final **thesis** (typically a two-year process).

**IMPORTANT:** To fully engage in this process and develop the practical skills needed to become a doctor, it is **essential** to understand and speak Italian before starting the 4th year

# ADE Seminars



**Attività Didattiche Elettive (ADE)** or **Elective Didactic Activities** are elective seminars or practical activities offered in addition to the course content.

They are not part of the learning outcomes, meaning their content will not be asked in the exams.

However, all medical students must accumulate **8 credits from ADEs** to graduate. Each ADE typically provides 0.2 credits.

Announcements for these activities are made on eLearning or communicated by professors.

Bookings are done individually, and for now, credits must be recorded in the libretto. Moving forward, the **GOMP** system will be used to register for these seminars, and credits will be saved automatically.

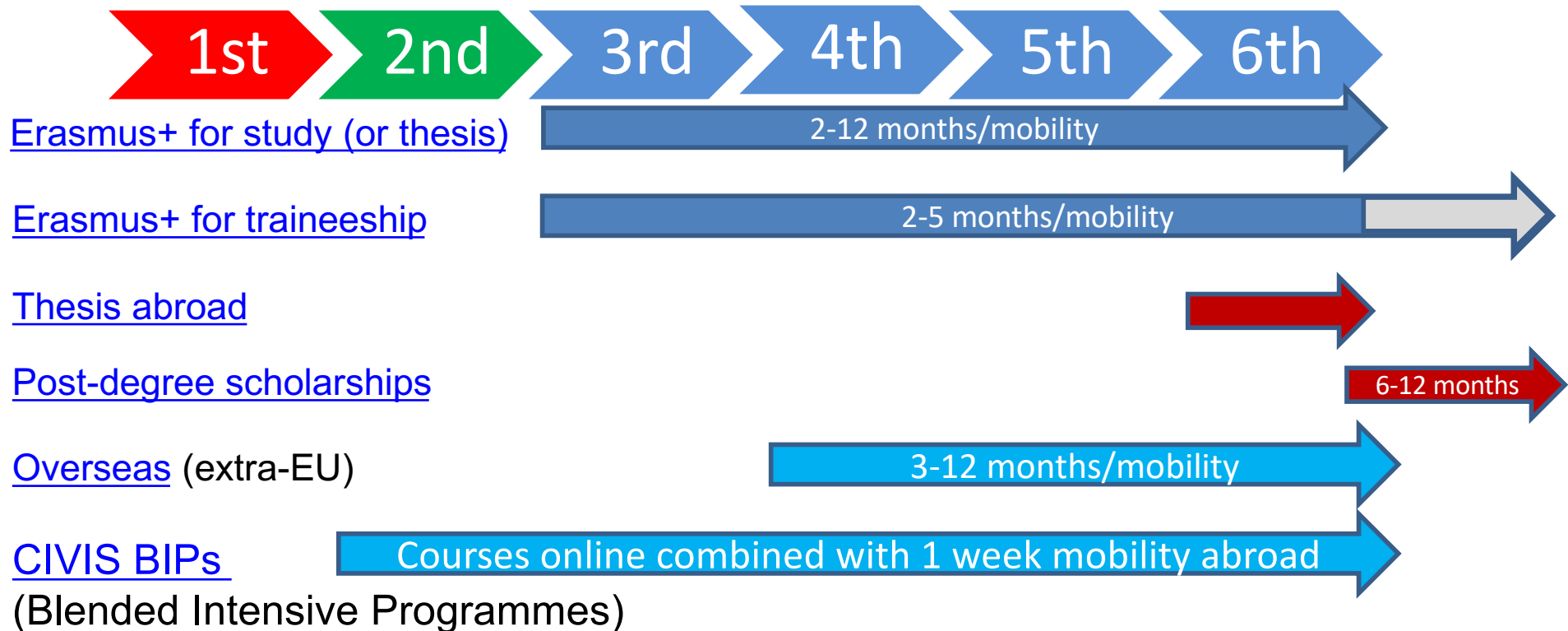
- 40-hour Italian language courses are delivered in-person and/or online during the second semester of the academic year (February–June)
- Students must attend at least 70% of the total course hours (28 hours out of 40) in order to be admitted to the final exam and receive a Certificate of attendance stating the student's language proficiency.
- A1 and A2 levels are online and recorded courses
- B1 and B2 are online interactive courses

**We are planning both social activities to encourage interactions between students and initiatives to facilitate learning Italian (Prof. Maria Conforti), along with additional programs to incorporate your Italian language skills in practice (Dr. Maria Greta di Paola).**

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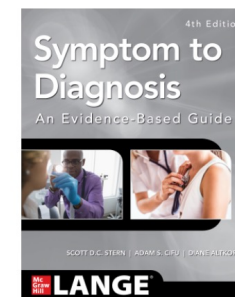

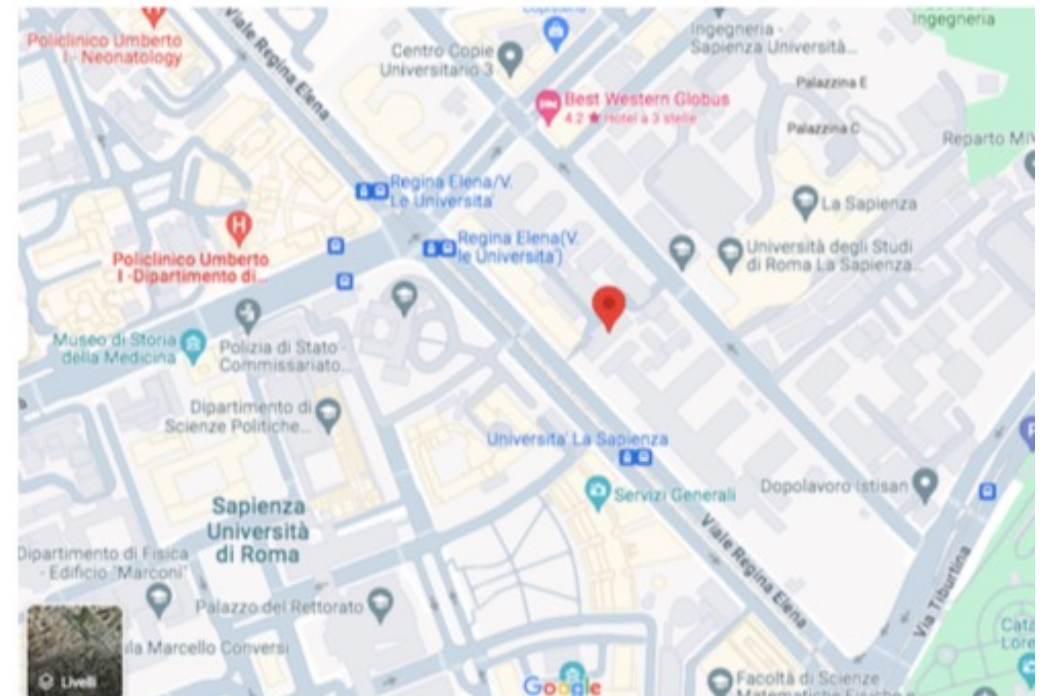

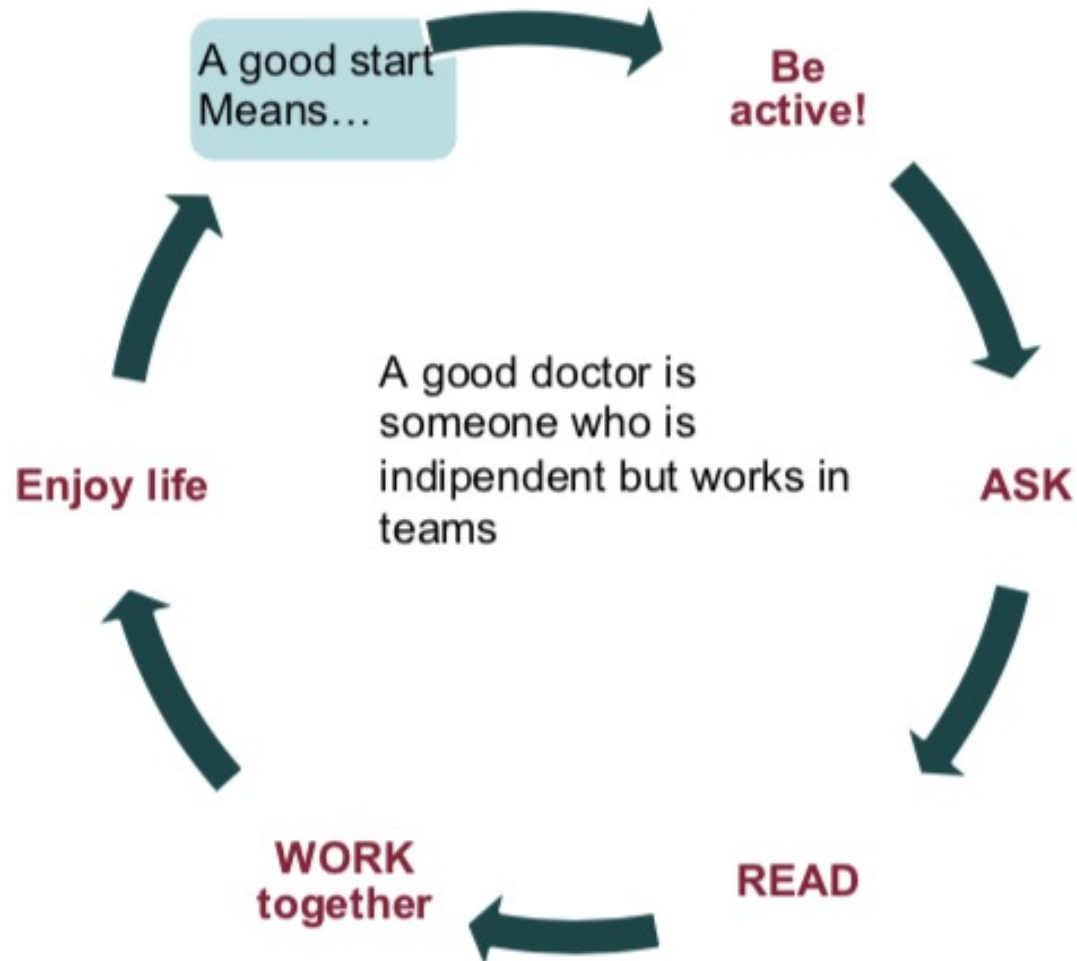
