- Societies, Culture and Heritage



CIVIS BIPs AND LA SAPIENZA

Documents Required:

Pre-BIP:

- Learning Agreement (LA)
- BIP contract
- Bank details

Post-BIP:

- Transcript of Records (ToR)
- BIP certificate
- Certificate of Recognition

Recognition of the course:

- 3 CFU per BIP as ADE credits are recognized if the BIP attended is relevant for the student's area of studies (noted in the description of each BIP)
- One can attend 2 courses in one academic year, and more throughout their studies.
 However, the student will be awarded a maximum of 6 CFU points.
- By whom: Prof. Dr. Giulia d'Amati, RAM (Responsabili Accademici Mobilità internazionale)

MOBILITY ELIGIBILITY

MAX 12 months per each study cycle
Ciclo unico: 24 months
BIPs mobility MUST be counted

FUNDING

- Funding is provided to students not receiving other scholarships for the duration of the physical mobility of the course:
 - 1. 79 €* for 5 days of the mobility. Additional 79 € for 2 days of travel. A total of 553 € received before the physical mobility part of the BIP.
 - 500 € upon successful completion of the course and approval of the documents by the RAM.

*The amount applies to BIPs in the academic year 2024/2025.

Furthermore, it is important to acknowledge that the funding might not cover 100% of the expenses of physical mobility.

FAQ

- Can I attend a BIP unrelated to my field?
 - No, there needs to be cohgerence betqween the BIP topiuc and your academic path.
- What comes first, the physical or the online part of the course?
 - This is specific to each course. You will find more information about this under *Practical Details* of the course on the CIVIS website.
- What type of examination method do CIVIS BIP courses utilize?
 - This is specific for each course. It will be communicated to you by the course coordinator. Examination might be oral, a written test, an essay, etc.
- Are all BIP courses taught in English?
 - No. Some courses are taught in Spanish or German. You can find this information *Practical Details* of the course on the CIVIS website.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE AND ADVICE

Medicine and Surgery Course F

Hosting University: National and Kapodistrian University of Athens

BIP: Children on the move: the health and well-being challenges of children refugee populations, Spring of 2024

The course started with the physical mobility part. Out of the 5 days, 2 were spent in the field, and 3 in a classroom. Lectures were held by the hosting university professors, as well as the representatives of numerous NGOs working in Greece and beyond. Lessons were held from 9am until 5pm. The course was very intense but extremely practical. Most speakers brought their own experiences into the classroom.

The group was made up of 12 students of various levels (Bachelor's, Master's, PhD) and from various fields (medicine, journalism, administration, public health, etc.). During the course, we were expected to create potential projects for the children of a RIC (Registration and Identification Centers). This taught us about the importance of interdisciplinary teamwork. Fieldwork consisted of two trips to RICs where we could learn about the process of identification of asylum seekers and ask questions to the administrative team.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE AND ADVICE

Online lessons were given by professionals in the field and involved long discussions. The lessons were recorded and shared with us for future revision.

The final examination was a 3000-word essay on a chosen topic, related to the title of the course. The examination is not to be taken lightly as it requires a lot of work that might not be of the nature we are usually used to.

At the end of the course, all lecturers offered opportunities for connecting with them via LinkedIn, and further research with the hosting university, as well as volunteer work at the facilities we visited. Some lecturers offered invitation letters to conferences.

Would I recommend a CIVIS BIP course? Absolutely! It has expanded my personal and professional circles, opened doors, and guided my choices in choosing my future profession.

Application advice:

While reading about the course, note the keywords in the course description. Use these keywords in your answers. Think about the ways you could **utilize** the course you are applying to in the future. This will help you find the **motivation** behind the application to the course. Mention your **previous experiences** in the field, write about the **perceived gaps** in your experience and knowledge, and explain how you **expect** the course to fill those gaps.
