

Q&A Session 2

December 10, 2025

The second Q&A session is meant to check your progress in developing the scientific content and structure of your video podcast. You should be able to present a coherent outline of your project, supported by data, literature, and visuals.

Each group should come with:

1. Draft scientific script (2–3 pages)

Clear structure of your podcast (introduction, clinical, molecular, therapeutic, and social parts).

Key references supporting your statements.

Preliminary narration or dialogue draft, indicating who will speak each part.

2. Slides (3–5 slides, first draft)

The clinical phenotype

The molecular/cellular mechanism

One or two key experiments

Current and potential therapies

Social or translational implications

3. List of sources and figures

Indicate which figures are original and which are adapted from scientific literature (with proper citation).

Be Ready to Discuss

How the **molecular and cellular biology** explains the clinical features.

Which **experiments** were crucial to understanding the disease mechanisms.

What **therapeutic strategies** exist or could be developed.

How you plan to make your podcast scientifically accurate but engaging and understandable.

How the **four group members** are contributing jointly to content preparation (not only to acting roles).

Each group will have **10 minutes** to present their progress.

Followed by **10 minutes of feedback and discussion**.

You may bring printed notes or show slides from your laptop.

This Q&A session is **formative**, not graded. It is meant to help you refine your script and scientific content before the final submission.

All group members must attend and participate actively.
