Luana Tomaipitinca is a researcher in cellular and translational science with a background in cellular and molecular biology and a PhD in Morphogenesis and Tissue Engineering from Sapienza University of Rome.

After completing her PhD, she expanded her expertise through postdoctoral research in immunology and tumour microenvironment at Sapienza University.

She then continued her postdoctoral training in hematology at Karolinska Institutet, focusing on the development of a novel protocol for neutrophil preparation for clinical transfusion.

Currently, she is a Researcher at Cellcolabs AB, a biotechnology company focusing on making high-quality stem cells available at industrial scale.

At Cellcolabs, she works on the development of potency assays to support mesenchymal stromal cell-based therapies.

Her career reflects a journey from academic research to biotech, driven by curiosity, adaptability, and a strong interest in translational science.

She was recently recognized with the Nordic Early Stage Professional Award from the International Society for Cell & Gene Therapy for her contributions to the field of cell therapy.
