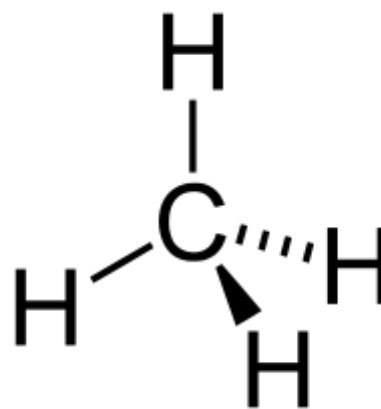

wedge-and-dash (*uncountable*)

1. (*chemistry*) A method of representing the three-dimensional structure of a molecule in which simple lines represent bonds in the plane of the image, wedge-shaped lines represent bonds towards the viewer and dashed lines represent bonds away from the viewer.
