

Exercise: Educational Attainment in Europe

1. Visit the Eurostat page on [Educational attainment statistics](#).
 - Read the introductory section and comment in general terms on the main findings.
 - For example: Which countries show the highest shares of people with tertiary education? How do men and women compare? What are some trends over time?
2. Download or copy the dataset that reports the share of **people aged 25–34 with tertiary education** by country.
3. Import the data into R (you may prepare the dataset as a CSV file before the exercise).
4. Using R, create a **bar chart** showing the percentage of young adults (25–34) with tertiary education across EU countries.
 - Make sure that countries are ordered from highest to lowest percentage.
 - Add axis labels and a clear title.
5. Briefly discuss:
 - Which countries stand out as leaders or laggards?
 - How does your own country compare to the EU average?
 - What might explain some of the observed differences?
