WORKSHOP

To mark the year 2013, as the Year of Italian Culture in the USA, the Honors Center of Italian Universities (H2CU) will organize a series of events - meetings and conferences - that will present the results of the ten years' activities of the H2CU in the US while outlining the strategy for future collaborations.

The leading "actors" have been Italian and American professors, students and researchers participating in the several multidisciplinary academic and scientific joint projects and programs. The H2CU programs have gathered an incredibly high number of students and academic professors coming from very different disciplines related to engineering, medicine, archeology, science and law, just to name a few.

Among the institutions involved, there have been twenty-one Italian universities and three Italian Research Institutes; whilst institutions of the United States included MIT, Columbia University, PACE University, Polytechnic Institute of New York University, Florida International University, Georgia Institute of Technology and Princeton University.

A summary of the activities, events and projects developed so far has been included in the "Special Issue" of the H2CU Magazine, that looks back at the successful experiences which will surely serve as the basis for coordinating and planning the discussions on future strategies and goals. While H2CU has been financially supported by several Italian public institutions and in particular by the Ministry of Education, University and Research, the H2CU strongly encourages, in the near future, fundings also coming from Italian private companies and individuals wishing to support young researchers in order to give birth to a new generation of international academics and professionals leading the way to an ever increasingly emerging globalized and challenging world.
